Sky Walk at Kottayam

The proposal of "Sky Walk Project" at Kottayam with an approximate cost of Rs. 4 crore submitted by the Transport Commissioner, Kerala was approved in principle by the Authority. It was decided that the ownership of the proposed Sky Walk will be vested with Motor Vehicle Department so that the fund required for the project will be transferred to the Motor Vehicle Department. The construction of Sky Walk will be entrusted with Roads and Bridges Development Corporation of Kerala Ltd. The Motor Vehicle Department has to obtain all necessary clearance for this project from the local body concerned, Town Planning Department, PWD etc. The recurring expenditure of the Sky Walk will be met by the DRSC Kottayam and the income from the Sky Walk such as rent from the shops etc will be collected by the DRSC.

It was also decided to conduct a check on the feasibility and technicality of the project jointly by the NATPAC and Roads and Bridges Development Corporation of Kerala Ltd.

Authority also approved the payment of Rs. 26,000/- to M/S Leo Associates, Chenganassery for the feasibility study plan and drawings of the project.
