Decision of the meeting

The 29th Kerala Road Safety Authority meeting held on 11.05.2016 decided to sanction an amount of Rs. 88,76,514/- for installing Automated Traffic Signal Systm including Solar Powered Source with 3 days autonomy and Count Down Timers at 7 junctions (Niramankara, Kaimanam, Pappanamkode, Karakkamandapam, Vellayani 1,

outsourced goods and services for implementing the works, the following conditions must be followed.

- ➤ KELTRON may purchase all bill of materials / services through Government of Kerala's e-tender system and KELTRON shall levy TSP charges only for outsourced goods and services.
- The fund release at actual may be done in phases subject to satisfactory inspection of the implementation phases for the bill of materials and production of proof of adherence of above conditions.
