Road Safety Fund – Release of Balance Amount

Non receipt of Utilisation Certificate from its Stake Holding Departments and District Road Safety Councils

The Authority decided not to release more fund to any department and District Road Safety Councils who have not yet furnished the Utilization Certificate or furnished only partial utilization certificate. The Motor Vehicle Department and Police Department agreed to furnish the UC and refund the balance amount to Kerala Road Safety Authority soon

Public Works Department has informed that the road safety measures cannot be implemented in NH region properly due to the construction /widening of roads. The Authority instructed the Public Work Department, Police Department and Motor Vehicle Department to implement road safety measures temporarily in NH region where new construction of road is under way. It is also decided not to release any further fund to PWD (NH) for providing road safety measures until the construction/widening work of existing National Highway is over.

The Authority also decided to arrange a video conference of all District Collectors with the Hon'ble Minister for Transport and Hon'ble Minister for Works soon to discuss about the action taken by each District Road Safety Councils to reduce the road accidents and issues related to the non-furnishing of Utilization Certificate of fund released by KRSA
