Identification & short-term improvement of Crash Blackspots in the State by NATPAC.

Decision:

1. Entrusted NATPAC to conduct identifications and prioritization of crash black-spots at an estimated cost of Rs.5,20,000/- with direction to submit report before 20/03/2019. Entire amount will be released on submission of report.

2. KRSA observed that improvement of black-spots should be carried out immediately on identification of the same. Hence stage-2 study proposed by NATPAC viz; "Preparation of short-term improvement measures for black-spots" at a unit rate of Rs.90,000/- plus GST per black-spot, towards professional

Service Charges is also approved. An amount of Rs. 67,50,000/- (Rupees Sixty seven lakh Fifty thousand only) is sanctioned for the purpose with direction to submit report within two months. 25% of the project cost shall be released as first instalment on submission report at (1) above, for stage 2 study.
